It is produced by Windows and distributed by Eros International. Veteran actors Soumitra Chatterjee and Swatilekha Sengupta played the lead roles in this film . The couple was last seen in Satyajit Ray's iconic film 'Ghare Baire' three decades ago. The film also stars Rituparna Sengupta, Aparajita Adhya, Monami Ghosh, Indrani Dutta, Sohini Sengupta, Kharaj Mukherjee, Shankar Chakraborty, Anindya Chatterjee,Sujoy Prasad Chatterjee, Barun Chanda and Sohag Sen in pivotal roles. Belaseshe is the story of the separation of a couple who are about to celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary. belaseshe is a story of relationships that explores the intricacies of a married life, the company of a lifetime, promises and expectations and the true meaning of love. Currently, the rights to 'Belaseshe' are with Viacom, a multinational media company. Plot 75 years Biswanath Majumdar was in the publishing industry. His wife, Arati, was 66 years old and they had been married for 49 years. Over the years, they were fortunate to have four children, the eldest being their son, followed by three other daughters, all now married and settled. Like most couples, Biswanath and Arati had adapted to each other's whims and weaknesses, and lived a compatible life. On the night of 'Dashami', in front of the assembled family, Biswanath Majumdar drops a bomb. He states that he finally decided to divorce his wife, their mother, Arati. But why after so many years? As harsh as the children were, they could not get any information about it from their father, while their mother seemed more indifferent to development. Biswanath files a divorce case. What happens in court where biswanath and arati were required to appear with their respective lawyers? What led Biswanath to make such a drastic decision? Did Arati finally raise her voice against Injustice? Is the couple finally divorcing after 50 years of married life? All these questions and many others form the node iconic film. Chief Justice Asim Chatterjee, known as the Puri Judge used to resolve marital disputes by sending separated couples to Puri. He also inspired the duo of directors in the making of this film. Prominent lawyer Jayanta Narayan Chatterjee has been involved in the legal terminology of the screenplay since its inception. Filming The film was shot in Kolkata and Shantiniketan. In fact, the house in Shantiniketan, where the film was shot has now become a tourist spot and is known as Alasesher Bari. (The house of 'Belaseshe') The filming of 'Belaseshe' ended in 17 days with a humungous cast. A total of 21 actors starred in the film. The entire cast and crew stayed in Shantiniketan, as a close-knit family, and finished filming in a week. In Kolkata, the film was shot in two different houses, both in South Kolkata. In fact, one of them was demolished just after the shooting ended, as the house was abandoned for the reconstruction of an apartment building and belaseshe became the first and last film to be shot there. The fair, presented in the film was created within 2.5 hours and within a limited budget of Rs.7500. The whole scene was shot in a frank way and the actors gave impromptu performances to make the sequence memorable. Swatilekha Sengupta's daughter, Sohini Sengupta, also the director of 'Belaseshe Kolahol' produced a pivotal performance in the film. Casting Veteran actors Soumitra Chatterjee and Swatilekha Sengupta were tied up in the main cast even before the script was finalized and incidentally, both actors signed up for the film on the same day. 'Belaseshe' is one of those films in the history of Bengali cinema that has a huge set cast. Pillars such as Rituparna Sengupta, Kharaj Mukherjee, Indrani Dutta, Aparajita Auddy, Shankar Chakraborty played key roles in the film. Bringing so many actors who are the most popular faces of Bengali cinema was a huge achievement for the production team. The actors themselves did justice to their roles and made the film the most successful and the most memorable of this decade. Release and reception The film was released on May 1, 2015 with 94% occupancy in theaters on the day of its release. The film was a runaway success and had a historic run of 250 days in one and 217 days in multiplexes. No other film ran continuously for 217 days in a multiplex. 'Belaseshe' became the oldest Bengali film in 2015. Nationally, the film was released in 25 centres across the country and lasted more than 50 days. The film was also critically acclaimed and it has an IMDb rating of 8.5 out of 10, book myshow rating of 4.6 out of 5. Director Mahesh Bhatt was so moved by the film that he wanted to get the remake rights. Malayalam actor Madhavan Nair aka Madhuji also wanted to remake the film. Director Umesh Shukla, renowned as '102 Not Out', wanted to make the film in Gujarati. Marathian veterans Ramesh Deo and Seema Deo wanted to remake the film in Marathi.
